 - "All Appropriate Inquiry"
 - Condemnation
- Litigation:
 - Typically, within the confines of the regulatory process, but sometimes court:
 - Administrative Permitting matter, Administrative Law Judge
 - District Court Comprehensive Environmental Response,
 Compensation, & Liability Act (CERCLA, or Superfund)
